Business:

- 1) Joey welcomed Troy Nickerson to the association.
- 2) Reviewed the number of registered players for each division. Midget numbers were lower so they will have an A, B, and a C. The A teams for both Pee Wee and Midget will have a full roster in order to be competitive.
- 3) The number and levels of Novice teams will be revisited during balancing.
- 4) Gina asked the member for feedback on the disciplinary documents as the association needs to create/update one.
- 5) The cost to upgrade Goalline is \$350 which the association will pay. Managers will be encouraged to use it more this season.
- 6) It was decided to buy both sets of jerseys (yellow and black) for Midget and Atom this year due to the cost and the work required to replace only one set in each division. Pee Wee and Bantam will use the jerseys with the old logo for this season. Novice will use the old Novice jerseys as well. Motion was put forward by Anne and seconded by Mike. It will be communicated to parents.
- 7) Cleves will be stocking name bars and socks for all teams. Joey is working with them to find ones that will coordinate with the new jerseys.
- 8) The new jerseys are \$65 a piece so the jersey deposit this year will \$130. Managers will collect the cheques.

- 9) Anne will be handing out jerseys directly to the teams this season.
- 10) The ice is on schedule to be ready for September 16. Gina shared a tentative schedule for conditioning camp. Tryouts will start around September 21.
- 11) The mezzanine will be open this season. Lori will draft a letter for the coordinators to share with all members regarding the guidelines for using the room.
- 12) The novice boards will require 4 people to put them up. HNS and the Dartmouth association could provide training for people to learn how to do it. Mike Langille is checking to see if volunteers will need insurance.
- 13) August 31 is the deadline to release players to Cole Harbour.
