<b>COVID 19 UPDATE</b>	<p>Public Health Announcement was made today that we will be back to status quo with practices, games, and spectators will be allowed back in the rinks. Everyone is working diligently on ice schedules and we should have teams on the ice by Friday. We are planning on using practice ice times to reschedule all missed games since the last shutdown. We have spoke to the rink and there will be no changes to the COVID procedures that we have been following prior to the most recent closure. Central minor games will continue Saturday and will also use practice rink time to make up the games that were missed. Dartmouth Rec will be trying to move forward with their original plan and attempt to make up games with practice ice times.
